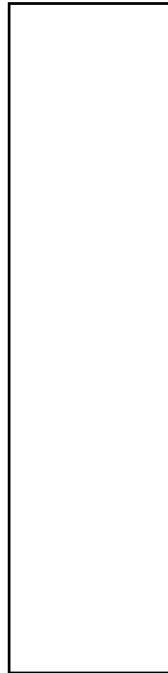

## **FROM THE DESK OF THE ADMINISTRATOR**

Your Board of Officers are still very busy in accomplishing our requirements associated with connecting to the sewer line and eliminating our septic system. At the present time we are awaiting final approval from the City of West Melbourne Planning Commission, the State Department of Environmental Protection and the City of Melbourne Village. Once these are finalized we will open the project up for bids. Our estimate of completion is that it should be done within the next 60 days.

Thanks to the efforts of Ian Simmonds, who oversees and plans special dances on the first and third Saturdays of every month and allocates all the profits to our building fund, so far this has accounted for approximately \$1800.00. We have also started having a Sunday dance once a month in our Lodge room with the proceeds also going towards our building fund. The first dance on Sunday June 5<sup>th</sup> net \$520.00 for the building fund. These dances are held without dinner being served and the cost is \$5.00 per person. You can bring your own snacks and we have the bar set up for purchasing refreshments.

These dances along with donations by members, Women of the Moose and Loyal Order of the Moose members conducting special drawings and events and members participating in our CD Loan program have resulted in our being about half way to our projected goals for the building fund. Any member interested in our CD program can earn from 3 to 4 percent interest on a three or four or five year program. Contact me at 321-720-4415 for more information on that program.

As you can see, there is a lot going on and there will be more to come. Many members of the LOOM and WOTM are very much involved in the building fund program and as a result it has been and will continue to be a success. Along with this program we still have our normal functions going on and as always, we could use more volunteers. Please consider volunteering so that we can expand our activities and offer more activities. We would like to start up the horse races and steak shoot in the Social Quarters but we need more volunteers. We can't nor will we add to the work load of the current volunteers.
