



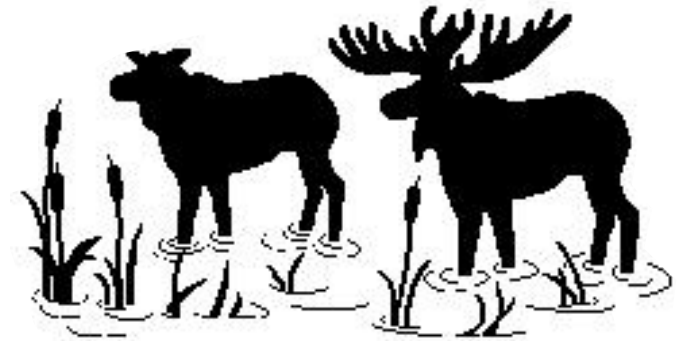

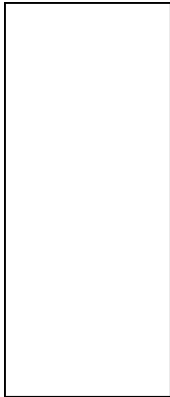

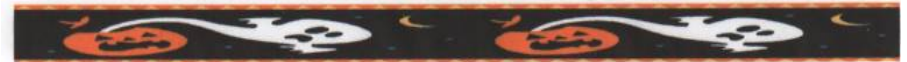
**LABOR DAY CELEBRATION

The members spoke, the Officers listened and as a result the Heartbeat, starting with this issue, will be published monthly and mailed to all members of the LOOM & WOTM.

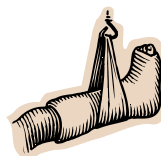
