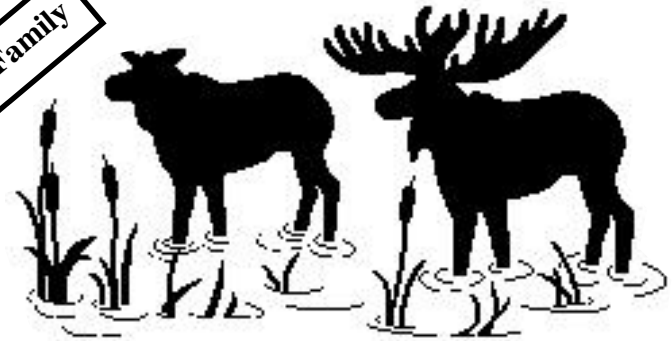

MICHAEL "MIKE" HYCZKA OUR MOOSE VOLUNTEER OF THE MONTH

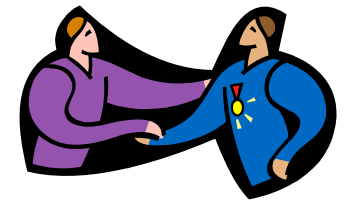


Mike has been a member of our lodge since March of 2002. He is married and his wife's name is Jennie. They have three children and three grandchildren.
