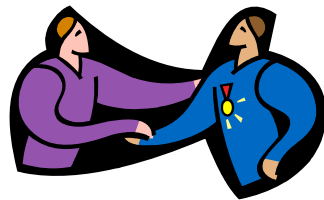


Ian can be found at every general membership meeting keeping up with all that is going on in our Lodge. Ian loves to dance and can be found on the dance floor at most of our dances.
