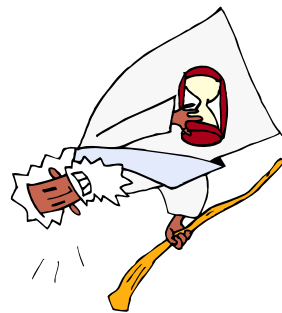

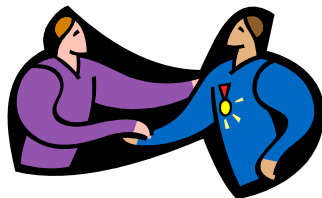
**GERDA BELTRAMI
